Only handmade arts & crafts are permitted. No Raffles. No giving away or selling food or beverages unless an approved food vendor. No alcoholic beverages.

Vendor space is a 12 x 12 area. Vendors supply their own tables, chairs and a maximum size tent of 10x10.

Be prepared to be on asphalt or grass. Tents must be self-supporting and include weights in case of strong winds. All vendors must have tents.

Vendors can only sell or display items listed on their application. We limit the # of vendors selling the same the same items. Your spot is not secured until your are approved and a non-refundable payment is received. You will be notified by email.

**Arts & Crafts Vendor Fee (Profit/Non-Profit): \$45** until Aug 15; **\$50** from Aug 15 -October 15 if spots are available. One spot per vendor unless approved by committee.

**Food Vendor Fee: \$200**

**Dessert/Snack Food Vendor Fee : \$150 (desserts and drinks that can be consumed at the festival)**

No drawings, raffles or auctions. No direct sales. No electricity is provided for vendors. Generators must be inverter generators. Sound systems in booths are not allowed unless approved. We strongly ENCOURAGE Friday set up: 2 p.m.- 6:00 p.m. Enter at the Museum's Entrance. An attendant will be at the entrance of the museum to direct you to your numbered booth. Unload and move your car to the designated parking area. Security will be present overnight.

Saturday set up: 7:30-8:30 a.m. Enter at Museum's Entrance. An attendant will direct you to your numbered booth and the vendor parking area. Unload your items. Move your vehicle and trailer to the designated vendor parking area asap. It is a short walk back to vendor area, but there are shuttles if needed. All vehicles are to be moved by 9:00 a.m. Vehicles arriving after 8:30 a.m. will not be allowed in the vendor area. Any vehicles that do not park in the designated parking area will be towed and will not be invited back to future events. Each vendor will be issued a parking pass upon arrival.

The Cherohala Skyway Festival is an equal opportunity event and does not discriminate regarding age, gender, race, creed, religion, or ethnicity. The festival reserves the right to reject any material or organization who does not reflect these values.
